Meeting was called to order by the Chair.

The Chair opened the meeting and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The First Order of Business was to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2022 meeting. A motion was made Mr. Trask, seconded by Ms. Mabry and passed unanimously.

Next, Troy Lachenmayer was introduced to be promoted from Probationary II Patrol Officer to Third Class. Lt. O'Brien told the Commission that Officer Lachenmayer faced a difficult obstacle raising to the top of the applicant list given his lack of prior police experience and Veteran Preference. However, he impressed the Oral Board, scored well and was hired. During the last year there were several serious Police calls, and the Lt. revised bodycam footage on each one, and Officer Lachenmayer stood toll in each incident. Officer Lachenmayer thanked Plymouth for taking a chance on him. Ms. Mabry noted that in his short time on the Department the Officer has received two certificates of merit. The Chair moved for the approval of the promotion, it approved unanimously.

Lt. O'Brien announced the passing of former Plymouth Officer Charles Quinn had passed away.

The Commission adjourned to Executive Session to discuss Personnel Matters.

The Commission came back into the Regular Session and approved the Eligibility List for the remaining applicants who had not withdrawn. The proposed list was approved unanimously.

There was no public comment.

The meeting adjourned at 7:15 PM.
