

Minutes of Civil Service Meeting

Meeting was called to order by the Chair.

Present: Members: Joseph Subbio, K. Mabry, Dr. Jones, Ardis Lukens. Mr. Trask was absent.

A quorum was present.

Also present: Solicitor: Thomas Speers, Lt. O'Brien

The Chair opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Sept. 14 Minutes were approved by a motion from the Chair. Ms. Lukens and seconded...The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Speers advised the Mr. Trask was notified he would not be reappointed as a member for a new term. There will be a new member appointed in January.

Lt. O'Brien reported that Officer Conrad's last shift would be Dec. 15. His official retirement will be later based upon terminal leave. He has served the Township for 26 years. Officer Keogh was hired as Conrad's replacement and is roughly half way done his Police Academy requirements. Lt. O'Brien thanked Ron Trask for his service to the board. A discussion followed with respect to the construction at the Township Building. There will be a transfer of a Patrol Officer to Detective. This will be a merit based lateral transfer. The process involves interviews and a recommendation to be made to the Chief. Ms. Mabry asked if this is an additional Detective slot. The Lt. stated it will eventually be that, but now it is needed due to Det. Pronzek's Military deployment. The Lt. updated the Commission on the progress of the recent hires. Calls are up and more crimes require investigation.

Mr. Speers announced that he would not seek reappointment as Solicitor to the Civil Service Commission. He stated that he would stay on an as needed basis until the Commission appoints a new Solicitor.

There was no public comment and the meeting adjourned at 6:50 PM
