The February Minutes were approved by a motion by the Chair and seconded by Mr. Trask. The motion passed unanimously.

The next order of business was the promotion of Officer Christopher Kerns from Third Class Patrol Officer to Second Class. The Chief's Certificate was presented, and Lt. O'Brien stated that Officer Kerns had prior experience as a Philadelphia Police Officer and was a great hire. His Sgt. Asked that he to be transferred to his squad because even though he was not long tenured with Plymouth he could work well without much supervision. Officer Kerns is a good person, good Cop and cares about this community. A motion for approval was made by the Chair and seconded by Dr. Jones. The motion passed unanimously.

The Solicitor reported on the status of the upcoming Entry Level Test and reminded the Commission that the test date is May 13 at the Fire Academy. Lt. O'Brien explained the efforts being used to promote the test, but like many other Municipalities the number of applicants is declining. The Lt. also requested that we move forward the proposed Rule changes.
