CODE ENFORCEMENT

PLYMOUTH MEETING, PA 19462
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Ordinance No. 1116 amending Chapter 3, Article II, and Ordinance No. 48 as amended which was adopted by Plymouth Township Council on January 11, 1993 requires the registration and licensing of amusements, circuses, carnivals, etc. to be operated within Plymouth Township.

The fee schedule for the licensing is:

1. For every circus or menagerie, for each day and / or night of exhibition, the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
2. For every carnival, show, exhibition or fair the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for one day and / or night of exhibition and operation and where the same continues for a longer period, the sum of fifty dollar (\$50.00) for each additional day and / or night of exhibition or fair is given or held by or for the benefit of a purely public charity exempt from taxation under Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and doing business as a corporation or association not organized for profit and permanently located within the Township, the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for one day and/or night of exhibition and operation, and whenever the same continues for a longer period, the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each additional day and night of exhibition or operation.
3. For every parade, procession or other exhibition or special event the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each day / and or night; except that when such parade or procession is conducted by or for the benefit of a purely public charity exempt from taxation under Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and doing business as a corporation or association not organized for profit and permanently located within the Township, or by an organized church, patriotic or religious organization, the fee shall be waived upon the completion and filing of the required bond and certificate of liability insurance.
