February 14, 2022

Plymouth Township Council held its Regular Meeting at the Greater Plymouth Community Center. The following officials were in attendance:

Pledge of Allegiance - The Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. and Chairman Manero led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT- There was no public comment pertaining to any items advertised on the agenda.

Recognition for Casper Prestia's 100th Birthday- Mr. Whitney read the proclamation recognizing Casper Prestia on the occasion of his 100th birthday. Mr. Whitney made a motion to approve the proclamation and was seconded by Ms. Bandish. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed 5-0 with Ms. Bramblett, Ms. Bandish, Ms. Viscio, Mr. Whitney, and Mr. Manero in favor.

Citizen Board Resolutions - ACTION-

- 1) Barbara Thompson- Mr. Manero read the resolution recognizing Barbara Thompson for her generous and outstanding service and contributions rendered while serving on the Parks and Recreation and Shade Tree Advisory Board from January 2013 to December 2021. Council extends its appreciation to Barbara Thompson who served with commitment and dedication. Mr. Manero made a motion to approve the resolution and was seconded by Ms. Bramblett. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed 5-0 with Ms. Bramblett, Ms. Bandish, Ms. Viscio, Mr. Whitney, and Mr. Manero in favor.
- 2) Jim Staples- Ms. Bandish read the resolution recognizing Jim Staples for his generous and outstanding service and contributions rendered while serving on the East Norriton-Plymouth-Whitpain Joint Sewer Authority Board from May 2017 to December 2021. Council extends its appreciation to Jim Staples who served with commitment and dedication. Ms. Bandish made a motion to approve the resolution and was seconded by Ms. Viscio. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed 5-0 with Ms. Bramblett, Ms. Bandish, Ms. Viscio, Mr. Whitney, and Mr. Manero in favor.

- 3) Sheldon Simpson- Mr. Whitney read the resolution recognizing Sheldon Simpson for his generous and outstanding service and contributions rendered while serving on the Civil Service Commission Board from January 2016 to December 2021. Council extends its appreciation to Sheldon Simpson who served with commitment and dedication. Mr. Whitney made a motion to approve the resolution and was seconded by Ms. Bramblett. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed 5-0 with Ms. Bramblett, Ms. Bandish, Ms. Viscio, Mr. Whitney, and Mr. Manero in favor.
- 4) K-9 Major- Recognition of Service- Chief Myrsiades stated K-9 Major served Plymouth Township for 11 years. He began his career with Detective Eric Ponzek, but he spent the bulk of his 10 years with Officer Michael Watts. K-9 Major conducted many sweeps for explosives, entertained at Plymouth Township Day, performed security inspections, and even apprehended suspicious actors. K-9 Major retried on January 1, 2021, sadly one year later on January 30, 2022 we said goodbye to K-9 Major one final time.
