

Recycling Loose Rechargeable Batteries

Due to increased recycling costs, the Township has implemented a \$5.00 per battery recycling fee for all rechargeable batteries.

What is considered a Rechargeable Battery?

- Rechargeable batteries are commonly found in cordless power tools, cordless phones, cellphones, cameras, two way radios, biomedical equipment, etc.
- Some rechargeable batteries look like your typical AA or AAA alkaline battery and will have rechargeable written on them. The recycling fee for these is as follows.
 - 0-10 Fee-\$5.00
 - 10 or more- \$10.00

Please note, rechargeable batteries inside of electronics do not need to be removed before recycling



Single-Use alkaline Batteries are not recyclable. They may be discarded in your trash.

-Single-use batteries are not reusable when they lose their charge. They are commonly found in remote controls, car keyless entry remotes, watches, pacemakers, hearing aids, memory backup fire alarm devices, toys, etc.
