PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP ALTERNATE SEWER CONNECTION PERMIT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this	day of	, 20, between PLYMOUTH
TOWNSHIP (the "Township") and	-	of

_____ (the "Applicant) and further described in the Plymouth

Township Sewer Connection Permit Application.

Applicant has applied to the Township for the right to sewer service pursuant to the Township's Sewer Connection Permit Agreement Program, in order to serve the parcel of land located within Plymouth Township, as specifically described in the attached Application which is made a part hereof; and,

As a condition precedent to Applicant's receipt of a permit under the Township's Sewer Connection Permit Program, the Applicant agrees to execute and be bound by the terms and provisions hereof:

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

1. The Township grants to Applicant the right to discharge permitted wastewater for transmission, treatment and disposal by the Township for ______ EDUs as calculated in the attached SEWER CONNECTION PERMIT AGREEMENT APPLICATION FORM, for the property located at ______, Plymouth Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

2. Applicant, simultaneously upon the issuance of this Agreement shall pay to the Township the sum of for said sewer connection permit. Payment shall be in the form of a bank check.

3. This Agreement incorporates by reference all of the provisions of the Tapping Fee Resolution of the East Norriton-Plymouth-Whitpain Joint Sewer Authority effective July 1, 2005 (the Resolution).

4. Any transfer, conveyance, or resale of the property described herein is subject to the terms of this Agreement and those set forth in the Resolution.

5. The Township has the unrestricted right to use all payments from Applicant under the Resolution and this Sewer Connection Permit Agreement for construction, capital expansion and additions of the treatment facilities, in accordance with the provisions of Pennsylvania Act 57.

6. Criteria established for estimating sewage flow used in calculating reserved capacity as set forth in this Agreement shall be as follows:

Sewage flow equivalent to 230 gallons per 200 gallons of estimated water usage Sewage flow shall be adjusted using equivalent days per week.

7. Township reserves the right to monitor the flow of the sewer connection at any time in the future, and if necessary, assess additional sewer connection charges and/or penalties in the event actual recorded flows exceed the flow estimated in the Applicant's application.

8. If, after additional monitoring the Township verifies the Applicant's sewer connection requires more EDUs than the number provided at the time of the initial application, the Applicant shall be required to purchase additional EDUs at a rate of 1.5 times the current Tapping Fee.

9. All applications received by Township under the Sewer Connection program shall be treated on a first come, first served basis, based upon written application filed with the Township, execution of this Agreement, acceptance by the Township and payment of the Tapping Fee.

10. In addition to the Tapping fee being paid there under, Applicant is responsible for any and all other sewer construction, connection and inspection charges, quarterly sewer rentals, permit fees, and costs of any other collection, treatment, and transmission facilities.

11. Applicant is not guaranteed and does not acquire any vested right in any zoning or land use approval of any kind or in the issuance of any permits or approvals or building permits for the property, which is the subject of this Agreement.

12. Applicant's conveyance or transfer of the property described herein to any other person, firm, corporation or entity shall in no way obligate the Township to provide sewer service to the transferee or purchaser unless said transfer is acknowledged and approved by the Township. The Applicant shall be obligated to notify the potential purchaser as to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. The Applicant shall be obligated to notify the Township prior to the transfer of the property that the prospective purchaser has been notified of the existence and contents of this Agreement.

13. This Agreement and this obligation shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns.
