

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Plymouth Township Council will hold a public meeting on Monday, February 14, 2022, 7:00 p.m., at the Greater Plymouth Community Center, 2910 Jolly Road, Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania 19462, to consider the enactment of an Ordinance abandoning certain public streets and accepting a certain public street, and amending the general plan of the streets of Plymouth Township, in accordance with a plan prepared for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

The proposed Ordinance to be considered and acted upon is the following:

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF FAIRFIELD ROAD AND DIAMOND AVENUE AS PUBLIC STREETS AND ORDAINING LUCETTA STREET AS A PUBLIC STREET IN PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The proposed Ordinance to be considered and acted upon on February 14, 2022 has been drafted for the proper management, care and control of the Township and the maintenance of peace, good government, health and welfare of the residents of Plymouth Township.

The proposed Ordinance provides for the abandonment of a portion of Fairfield Road as well as abandonment of Diamond Avenue as public streets of the Township and acceptance of Lucetta Street as a public street within the Township. The proposed Ordinance includes a severability clause, a savings clause, and an effective date.

The full text of the Ordinance may be examined without charge or obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof during normal business hours at the Plymouth Township Municipal Building, 700 Belvoir Road, Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania.
