
## **LEISURE POOL OPEN RECREATION POLICIES & FAMILY AREAS**

Family Reservations for open swim are available for Monday, Feb 15th at 12:00pm, 2:00pm, & 4:00pm. Each reservation is for one and a half hours and there are five reservations available for each time slot. Each reservation is for one household/family up to five (5) and all must live in the same residence. At least one parent or guardian must have a valid GPCC membership.

## **Before Your Visit:**

- Each Household/Family will be assigned a marked area on the deck (See diagram above). This will be their designated area to ensure proper social distancing and keep their belongings. Patrons from the same Household/Family are not expected to practice social distancing with each other.
- Patrons may bring their own chairs. We will not provide any benches or chairs for open swim.
- Parents are always responsible for the actions of their children. Parents must be active managers of their children and ensure they understand the new guidelines.

## **Entering, Exiting and Moving around the Aquatics Center:**

- Please arrive on time and check in at the front desk
- Enter the Aquatics Center through the Locker Rooms
- When moving around the pool deck follow the green arrows on the ground & walls (The arrows are in a clockwise direction so it is easy to remember!)
- When you leave, follow the arrows to the exit through the locker rooms or double doors next to the pool office.
- Please exit the pool area immediately after your reservation. Staff needs time to clean and disinfect.

## **Important Safety Rules and Regulations:**

- Parents and Chaperones of children, not lifeguards and staff, are responsible for ensuring their children social distance while at the facility.
- Face masks must be worn when not in the water.
- Maintain the CDC recommended social distance of 6 feet from others at all times (Including Lifeguards)
- Please use the deck shower to rinse prior to pool use.
- We cannot lend out any equipment and this includes life vests. Patrons with weak or non-swimmers are required to bring their own US Coast Guard approved life vests. All weak or non-swimmers must wear a life vest and must be accompanied by a responsible adult or guardian at all times.
