

Leisure Pool Open Recreation Reservations & COVID-19 Related Rules

Reservations can be made on our website through Sign-up Genius:

- Open Recreation Reservations are available to GPCC Monthly or Annual Pass Holders.
 - Each reservation is for one household/family up to five (5).
 - Attendees must live in the same residence.
 - At least one parent or guardian must have an active GPCC pass.
 - There is a \$12 fee for each household member without an active pass.
 - Each household will be assigned a marked area on the deck that will be their designated space for their reservation.
 - Reservation is for use of the Leisure pool only – No Lap Pool or Whirlpool.
- Reservations are available for Monday, February 15th at 12:00pm, 2:00pm & 4:00pm. Each reservation is for 1.5 hours.
- Patrons are to arrive on time and depart on time for cleaning & disinfecting between reservations.
- A maximum of five households will be allowed in the leisure pool area at one time.
- We have limited space in the Locker Rooms for showering & changing – please read posted policies before use.
- Facemasks must be worn when not in the water.
- Seating will not be provided; patrons may and are encouraged to bring their own chairs.
- No parties or other gatherings.
- The pool area is subject to closures & safety checks, as needed.
- Social distancing is required - please be respectful of others' personal space.

Lifeguards: Our guards cannot wear masks in case of a rescue. Please keep a minimum of 6-feet between you and them.

Questions & Assistance: A member of the Management Team will be on the deck or in the office to answer questions or help with any issues.

Facemasks: Must be worn when moving around the deck.

Pool Equipment: We cannot lend out any equipment and this includes life vests. Patrons with weak or non-swimmers are required to bring their own US Coast Guard approved life vests. All weak or non-swimmers must wear a life vest and must be accompanied by a responsible adult or guardian at all times.

Slide: A Slide Attendant will be stationed at the bottom of the slide to ensure the following:

- Proper height – users must be at least 4' tall
- Use of hand sanitizer before utilizing the slide
- Patrons safely enter and exit the slide – Only one patron may use the slide at a time

Social Distancing & Supervision of Children: Parents and Chaperones of children, not lifeguards and staff, are responsible for ensuring their children social distance while at the facility.

Patrons from the same household are not expected to practice social distancing with each other.

Patrons shall observe the recommended 6-foot separation from other non-household people in the pool and on the deck.

Parents are always responsible for the actions of their children. Parents must be active managers of their children and ensure they understand the new guidelines.
