Sellers & Buyers are required to wear a face covering

<u>Set-Up:</u> All labor is the responsibility of the seller. Plymouth Township staff will not be available to provide set-up assistance. Each vendor must stay within the designated space assignment. No electricity will be provided. Set-up is from 7am-8am.

<u>Hours of Operation</u>: The yard sale will run from 8am-12pm. No cars will be allowed to drive through the lot during the hours of operation.

<u>Clean-Up:</u> All clean-up is the responsibility of the vendor. No items or trash may be left behind. If anything is left in your designated area you will be subject to a fine. Clean-up is from 12pm-1pm.

<u>Tents, Tables & Space</u>: You will be given 3 parking spaces as your designated parking and selling space. You MUST use one space to park your vehicle. You may not move your vehicle between 8am and 12pm. You may bring your own 10x10 pop up tent if you would like. You are responsible for providing your own tables and chairs. Your tent, tables and chairs must fit in your designated space. No tables will be available to rent.

<u>Food, Beverage & Fundraising:</u> The sale of any food or beverage is not permitted unless permission from the township is obtained. No fundraising is allowed unless proper approval has been granted.

<u>Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco</u>: No alcohol or tobacco products are allowed to be sold or consumed. All Plymouth Township property is tobacco free.

<u>Trademarked/Counterfeit Merchandise</u>: The sale, display or distribution of merchandise that infringes upon copyrighted design or materials or bears counterfeit trademarks is prohibited.

<u>Other Restrictions:</u> No commercial sales or fundraising will be allowed. This includes, but is not limited to Avon, Tupperware, Thirty One, etc. No firearms, ammunition, martial arts weapons, drugs, drug paraphernalia, over the counter medication, raffles or lotteries may be sold.

<u>Handmade/Craft Sales:</u> The sale of handmade and craft items are permitted, however permission must be given by Township.

<u>Sound:</u> Please keep all sound emitting merchandise to a minimum. Be courteous to your neighbor. You may be asked to turn something off or down if it is causing a distraction.

Animals: No animals are allowed to be sold or given away.

<u>Parking:</u> You will be assigned 3 parking spots. You MUST park a car in one of your spots. The other two spots can be used to sell your goods. Parking is at a premium so this will be strictly enforced.
