



In honor of National Physical Fitness and Sports Month in May, my offices will be collecting new and gently used sneakers to be donated to Mitzvah Circle.



Reminder: Taxes due April 18



The April 18 tax deadline is coming soon, and I wanted to remind you that state tax forms are available in my district offices. Please feel free to stop by to pick up the forms you need or give us a call and we will mail them directly to your home.

The Department of Revenue is encouraging taxpayers who are able to file their PA personal income tax returns online at mypath.pa.gov.

In addition, the department has <u>extended customer service hours</u> to offer taxpayers help by phone. Personal income tax assistance will be available between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. Monday through Friday by calling 717-787-8201. Help is also available <u>online</u>.

The IRS has programs that offer free basic tax return preparation to qualified individuals. Details are available on the IRS website.
