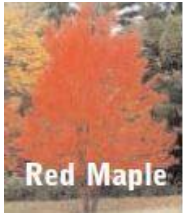

Shade Trees

- Red Maple – Acer Rubrum.
Foliage turns brilliant red in the fall.
- River Birch – Betula Nigra.
Striking bark, purple red leaf during the season.
- Black Gum – Nyssa sylvatica.
Outstanding fall color.
- Tulip Poplar – Liriodendron Tulipifera.
Green flowers in early summer.

Ornamental Trees

- Service Berry – Amelanchier arborea.
Green flowers in early summer.
- Redbud – Cercis Canadensis.
Purple flowers in spring.
- Dogwood – Cornus Florida.
Produces white or pink flowers in the spring.

Category 1: \$350 to purchase and plant a tree with 1.5” caliper
 Category 2: \$500 to purchase and plant a tree with 2.5” caliper
