COVID-19 Vaccines for Children Under 5

As you may have heard, this week the CDC has authorized COVID-19 vaccinations for [children six months and older](#).

A three-dose Pfizer vaccine for children under five years old and a two-dose Moderna vaccine for children under six years old, have been approved for children as young as six months. Parents seeking appointments for children under three should contact their pediatrician, family doctor or other qualified physicians.

In addition, the Montgomery County Office of Public Health is now scheduling vaccine appointments for children ages 6 months through 4 years, with clinics offering both Moderna and Pfizer vaccines.
