PA House Fellowship Program



The Pennsylvania House Legislative Fellowship Program is currently accepting applications for the Spring 2023 session.

The 13-week Fellowship Program is based in Pennsylvania's Capitol Building in Harrisburg where Fellows will be placed in committee chair and House Leadership offices.

Qualified applicants include:

- Undergraduate juniors and seniors, graduate students, and law school students.
- Enrolled in a Pennsylvania college/university or a Pennsylvania resident enrolled in an out-of-state institution.
- Students of any major with a GPA of 3.0 or higher are encouraged to apply.

Unemployment Compensation Fraud is a serious matter. The Pennsylvania Department of Labor & Industry (L&I) is committed to preventing, identifying, and blocking scams and is continuing its aggressive efforts to do so, including:

- Cross-matching data with other state agencies and across the country to detect fraud activity.
- Working with the U.S. Department of Labor to prevent and detect fraudulent activities related to UC.

Pennsylvanians should remain vigilant and [report fraud or any potential concerns of fraud to L&I](#). Cashing the checks or using directly deposited funds knowing that you have not applied for any unemployment program may be deemed fraud and repayment will be required.
