

RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - 14

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE CODE
OF ORDINANCES AT PART II [GENERAL LEGISLATION], CHAPTER 14 [OFFENSES AND
MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS], ARTICLE III [EMERGENCY POLICE AND FIRE
ALARMS]**

WHEREAS, the Township of Plymouth is a home rule municipality (the “Township”) organized and existing under the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Township’s own Home Rule Charter (the “Charter”); and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 301 of the Home Rule Charter, all powers of the Township are vested in and exercised by a Council, including the power to make and adopt ordinances and resolutions consistent with the Constitution and laws of the Commonwealth and the Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Plymouth Township desires to create a fee schedule for Article III, Chapter 14 of the Township Code of Ordinance;


WHEREAS, the Council of Plymouth Township has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Township and its residents to create a fee schedule for Article III, Chapter 14 of the Township Code of Ordinance as follows:

1. False Alarm Fee – Business
 - a. 4 or more False Alarms Within One Calendar Year (Each) – **\$300.00**
2. Alarm Permits Fee
 - a. Residential Alarm Permit – **\$25.00**
 - b. Business Alarm Permit – **\$100.00 initial permit fee and thereafter \$100.00 annually. Annual permit fee waived if updated permit is received by the Township by March 31st of each calendar year.**
