

GROUP SWIM 2026 – DISCOUNTED RATE \$10/PERSON

Group Swim Reservation Information

1. Call the Aquatics office 610-313-4060 to book your Group Swim.
2. Reservations must be made at least 1 week in advance.
3. A minimum of 10 swimmers is required for discounted rate.
4. The price for the Group Swim is \$10 per person - All participants entering the water are required to pay. *Please review Adult/Child ratio requirements and Pool Rules for weak and non-swimmers as adult accompaniment in the water is required.*
5. A \$100 **Non-Refundable** deposit is required to confirm the reservation.
6. Group Swim will take place in the Leisure Pool Only.
7. The remaining balance, along with the final headcount, for the Group Swim is to be paid at the front desk on the day of your scheduled Group Swim.

Note: Organized Groups (Camps, Day Cares, Schools, Scout Troops, etc.) must provide a Copy of Insurance (COI) with Plymouth Township listed as additional insured. COI is to be emailed to Aquatic@plymouthtownship.org, prior to reservation date. Failure to provide COI will result in cancellation of the Group Swim and loss of deposit – no exceptions.

8. Group Swim reservations are available Saturday & Sunday 12:00pm – 3:00pm. During the Summer schedule groups are welcome to book on weekdays 10:00am-12:00pm or 12:00pm-2:00pm.

Arrival Information:

1. The entire group must be present at GPCC to receive the discounted Group Swim rate. Otherwise, you will be charged the day pass rate.
 - Check in at the front desk
 - Fill out Group Non-Parental form if one has not been filled out in advance.
 - Pay balance – All participants entering the water are required to pay. Please see Adult/Child ratio requirements below.
 - Receive wristbands – All swimmers must have one.
2. Proceed to aquatic center bleachers where GPCC staff will review rules if requested, check adult/child ratios, and direct participants to the Leisure Pool where the Group Swim will take place.

Note: If participants need to change into their swimwear, they may use the appropriate locker room and must be supervised at all times. Use of lockers is prohibited; all Group Swim belongings can be stored in the green cubbies or on a section of the bleachers on the pool deck.
3. All weak or non-swimmers **must** be fitted with a US Coast Guard approved life vest - GPCC has loaner vests available for use.
4. The group will then be directed to the Leisure Pool where the Group Swim will take place.

Swimming Ratio Requirements:

Children 1-2 years 1 Adult: 2 Children - The adults must be in the water closely supervising children

Children 3-5 years 1 Adult: 4 Children - The adults must be in the water closely supervising children

Children 6 years & up 1 Adult: 8 Children - The adults may supervise from the pool deck or in the water

These adults must keep their eyes on the children at all times, assist taking the children to the bathroom and other areas as needed. ALL non-swimmers MUST wear a US Coast Guard approved life vest.

Management reserves the right to confine groups to the zero depth/wading area and prohibit slide use should there be unsafe conditions.

Group Swim Policy & Procedure Summary:

Group Leaders are required to read all **GPCC Group Swim Policies** and **Aquatics Center Rules & Regulations** prior to your visit. Our policies have been set up for the safety of all patrons using the community center - it is very important that you understand the content, requirements, and expectations of your group. Failure to obey facility rules or to follow policies may result in ejection from the facility for your entire group with no refund and denial of future group bookings.

Rules & Regulations

- Groups are permitted in the **Leisure Pool only** – No Lap Pool, No Hot Tub, No Sauna.
- Adults/Chaperones must supervise children at all times.
- All weak or non-swimmers **must** wear a US Coast Guard approved life vest and **must** be accompanied by a responsible adult or guardian at all times.
- Use of lockers is prohibited; all belongings can be stored in the green cubbies or on a section of the bleachers on the pool deck.
- Running is not permitted anywhere in the Aquatics Center.
- Diving is not permitted in the Leisure Pool.
- Sitting, standing, or climbing over the dividing walls within the pool is not permitted.
- If children will be using the Fish Slide, there **must** be a chaperone in the catch area. There should be a second chaperone on the deck behind the Fish Slide to properly supervise the children.
- Food and drink is not permitted in the Aquatics Center.
- You **must** be at least 4 feet (48 inches) tall to use the Big Red Slide. **No exceptions.**
 - ❖ Only one rider on the slide at a time
 - ❖ Remove goggles and/or eyeglasses and hold them in your hand
 - ❖ Go down the slide lying on your back, feet first, & face up
 - ❖ Exit the catch basin through the gap in the wall **to your right**
- Safety Checks will be done at the discretion of Aquatics Management – please use them for bathroom breaks.
- Follow directions given by the lifeguards, chaperones, party leaders/camp counselors, they are here to keep you safe.
- The GPCC does not offer rain checks or refunds for any reason. This includes any pool closures, mechanical or chemical issues, and fecal incidents.
- GPCC reserves the right to change pools/cancel recreation swim sessions if staffing /water conditions warrant.

Important: These policies are to be distributed & reviewed thoroughly by all chaperones. In addition, they are to be reviewed with all participants the day of the swim.
